Cooperative Preschool can be a very rewarding experience for your child. This is his/her own place where his/her fun, needs, and feelings are a primary importance to the adults present. Here, he/she is free to be as active as he/she wishes. There are new and exciting toys and opportunities for creative play and many playmates. Preschool provides an ideal arrangement for a child to enjoy himself/herself and to learn many skills.

From a parent's viewpoint, the preschool provides play and learning experiences under the direction of a trained, objective teacher in an environment that is carefully planned to fit the child among playmates who are the same age. - 2. Health and Registration Forms: A health form as well as other various enrollment papers will be sent to you during the summer. All forms must be signed, dated, and completed **BEFORE** your child can attend school. Immunizations must also be up to date.
- **3.** Your child must be **completely** toilet trained before attending preschool. (No pull-ups.)
